## **Additional Locations Defined**

a place where instruction takes place and students can complete 50% or more of an academic program

## Assumed Practices: Faculty Roles and Qualifications

Instructors possess an academic degree relevant to what they are teaching and at least one level above the level at which they teach

## Criteria for Accreditation Four Criteria Mention Dual Credit

- Faculty credentials-all instructors are appropriately credentialed
- Rigor-the same level of rigor as regular college courses
- Outcomes-the institution's program quality and learning goals are consistent across all modes of delivery and all locations
- Access-students and faculty have the same access to learning resources
- Monitoring and Oversight-proper monitoring exists to ensure standards are being met.
